EMPTY AEROSOL CANS – GO IN TRASH

NEVER MIX CHEMICALS

- ◆ Use original container, tighten caps and lids.
- ◆ Sort and pack separately, oil paint, pesticides and household cleaners.
- ◆ Pack in sturdy upright containers and pad with newspaper.
- ◆ Do not place in garbage bags.
- ◆ Never smoke while handling hazardous material.

BATTERIES

NON-HAZARDOUS batteries that can be thrown away are: Alkaline AA, AAA, C, D, 3, 6, 9, and 12 volt.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES such as Nickel Cadmium, Lithium Ion, Nickel Metal Hydride, Small Sealed Lead should be recycled and brought to the lower level of the Library and Town Hall during normal hours of operation. They can be found in cell phones, cameras, clocks, hearing aids, power tools, and remote control toys.

LATEX PAINT

is non-hazardous – please do not bring. Solidify and put in your trash. If can is more than 1/2 full bring to our Paint Collection Center at the Highway Dept every Monday. (Holidays excluded) 7:30 am to 3:45 pm.

MERCURY ITEMS

Fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, all mercury bearing items may be dropped off every Monday (holidays excluded), 7:30 am to 3:45 pm.

REMINDER

may be brought to the Highway Dept, 7:30 am – 3:45 pm, Mon – Friday

TIRES, CRT's

are part of the Curbside Program and picked up by appointment every Friday

may be brought to the Highway Department every Monday (holidays excluded) 7:30 am – 3:45 pm April – Oct.
